# Dana Point Hardware

### A Family of Hardware-heads

Three generations keep Dana Point Hardware true to community, customers

What does one get when they mix equal parts knowledge, quality and family? The answer: Dana Point Hardware—a family-run operation nearing its 40th year of service. Plainly put, the Sandberg family knows simple repairs; they know major renovations too.



Whether customers catch Bill Sr., Susan, Billy or Crystal in their Del Prado Avenue-located shop, this family of experts is sure to have an answer on everything from paint, to plumbing and bolts, to baseboards. That's three Sandberg generations who are dedicated to ensuring their clientele of do-it-yourselfers have top home-improvement products accompanied by the very best in service.

Bill Sandberg Sr. began working in the hardware industry in his hometown of Burbank back in the early 1950s. A few years after marrying, Sandberg and his late-wife Carolyn—parents to Bill Jr. and Susan, now Susan Basanda—purchased Frasier Park Lumber and Hardware, but medical issues ultimately led to the company's sale.

Too young to retire and not ready to fold on the hardware trade, Bill and brother Bernie joined forces and their hunt for a coastal storefront began. They looked at communities from Seal Beach to Oceanside, eventually choosing Dana Point. Even with three competing hardware stores nearby, the beach town with a newly dedicated harbor provided the perfect backdrop and business opportunity. The family opened their store's doors in 1976 to the blessings and friendly welcomes of neighboring businesses.

"Mr. DeNault (Jim), of DeNault's in San Clemente, came over and said 'Welcome to the neighborhood, there is room for everyone here,'" Basanda recalled while cutting a key for a customer.

For a year after opening, Bill and Carolyn lived in a camper behind the store before relocating to the harbor. With both children out of the home, the couple jumped at the opportunity to live differently—they chose a harbor-docked sailboat and remained living there for 19 years.

Their kids followed them in 1979 and started decades-long careers by their father's side. Bill Jr. has since retired while Basanda continues her involvement in the day-to-day operations, joined by her son Billy and niece Crystal, who—like their parents—grew up in their grandfather's hardware store.

"When you grow up in a family business, it is just second nature to stay in a family business," Basanda said. "For some people that might be a challenge, for us it is simply a way of life. The only drawback is you don't get to go on vacation together, ever."

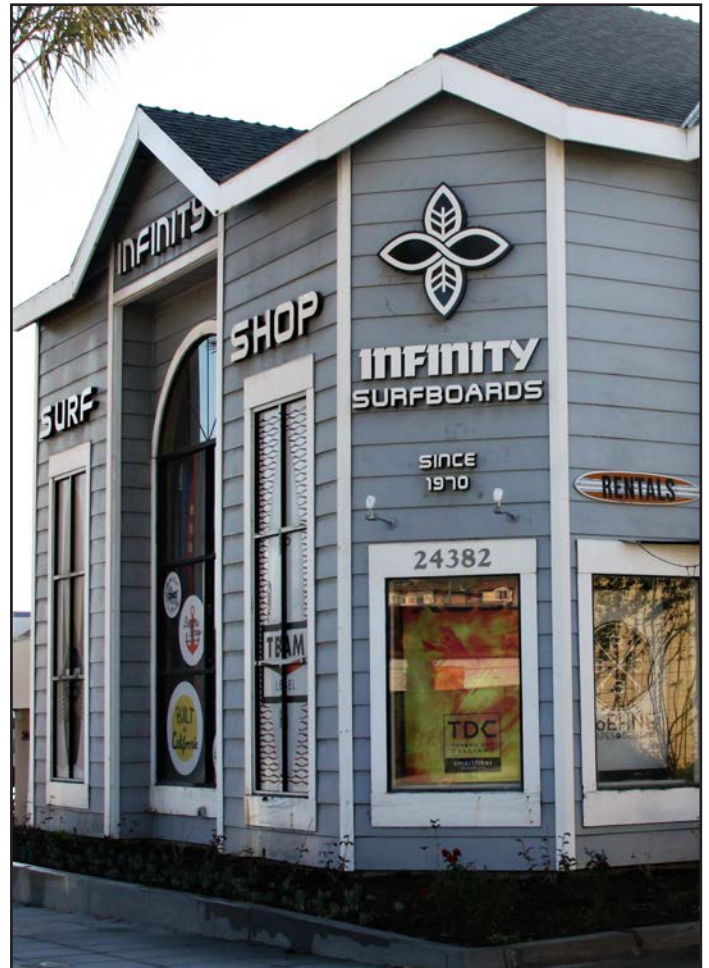
# Infinity Surf

When looking up the definition of tandem in the Merriam-Webster Dictionary, it would be fitting to find a picture of Steve and Barrie Boehne.

Look at the word, either as a noun, adverb or adjective, and the Boehnes fit the Bill. As a noun, tandem means, "a group of two people or things that work together or are associated with each other." Check. They've been working side-by-side for more than four decades—as tandem-surfers, as a married couple and, since 1971, as business partners when the first Infinity Surf Shop opened in Huntington Beach.

It's a partnership that has traversed the globe with Steve and Barrie sitting amongst the 1970's top tandem surfers and competing together until 2007. It has seen the birth of two sons, the beginning of a brand, the evolution of sport and the creation of more than 40,000 surfboards—most at the hands of Boehnes, Steve along with sons Dave and Dan bearing the lemniscate or infinity symbol," a perfect representation.

And so, Infinity Surfboards has stood the test of time, due—in equal parts—to the Boehne family's commitment and its patriarch's ability to embrace change without reserve. Longboards, shortboards, tandem boards, waveskis and stand-up paddleboards, name it and Infinity shapers probably make it. They haven't fought surfing's cultural transformation; rather, they've accepted trends and ridden their waves.



"Surfboards are very much like clothing, in that they are both things that evolve and styles that change," said Steve Boehne. "We look back at the bellbottoms of the '70s and say, 'Well those are kind of funny.' But in the same way you look at the surfboards of the '70s and they are hilarious and weird."

"Boards evolve and things come back," he added. "You try to make yourself fall within the trends. . . . So, you look at what's popular and make it recognizable to the brand."

Boehne started surfing at 12. It was 1959 and he hit South Bay spots in Torrance and Redondo Beach. He shaped his first board with neighbors a year later and hasn't stopped since. Content with the waves of his youth, an inland move to San Bernardino introduced him to a new world. The young shaper was forced to explore and wound up in Dana Point and San Clemente surfing the likes of Trestles and Doheny.

In 1968, after hundreds of garage shaped and glassed boards, Boehne landed a job with Gordie Surfboards where he grew in his craft and averaged finishing 50 boards a week for local surf shops.

"When you shape, it is almost like being an artist . . . at the end of the day when it is done, you see all the boards lined up that you shaped that day," Boehne said. "You are physically tired, but mentally fulfilled."

Soon after, Steve met Barrie through tandem surfing—she was an

accomplished tandem surfer who had partnered with the epitome of a waterman, Preston "Pete" Peterson, while Boehne was a novice.

"She really learned how to swim once she started surfing with me," Boehne said.

The Infinity brand was born in 1970 after a round of beers produced the name and logo. Boehne designed the brand's first board thereafter—it's a never-ridden, 7-foot, single-fin, balsa wood board with the "#1" printed on the tail. He and Barrie married in 1971 and opened their first shop in Huntington Beach.

At one point in time, Infinity Surfboards had shops throughout Southern California, in San Clemente, San Diego, and Mission Viejo. But since 1986, Infinity, and the Boehnes, have called Dana Point home. With Barrie on the books, Steve on the planer, eldest son David on the design and marketing plans, and younger brother Dan, a local dentist, in the shop shaping boards on the weekends, Infinity has thrived.

But as Boehne put it, right now "is actually the best time over the last 40 years."

# Luciana's

At 101 years old, Mary Vallera ("Nonna") still worries about her pasta.

If Vallera had it her way, she would be in the kitchen overseeing operations, making certain each of her recipes was executed with precision. But these days she puts her trust in grandson Jorge Luhan II. Chefs at Luciana's Ristorante know the recipes, he confirms when asked. They've learned from the best.

It is with the same great care and passion for tradition that they craft Vallera's Italian classics, from Penne Puttanesca to Ravioli de Vitello—handmade ravioli served in a wild mushroom ragu.

Even though she hasn't been a daily presence in the kitchen fixture for years, Vallera's traditions reverberate throughout Luciana's, which has served up time-honored, regional Italian dishes since 1983. Nonna's signature is not only on the dishes, it is also on the overall restaurant experience that stems directly from the family table.

And at the start of its 32nd year, Jorge, a third generation restaurateur, is ensuring his family's rituals and grandma's recipes are carried on at his mother Lucia Luhan's namesake bistro Luciana's Ristorante.

Originally from the Abruzzo region of Italy, the Vallera family came to the United States in the late-1930s and brought along their deep-rooted cultural customs. One of the family's treasured traditions continues to this day, both



at home and at Luciana's, meals between family and friends that stretch for hours.

"We share this ideal that was instilled in us when we were younger," Jorge said. "Luciana's isn't just a restaurant; it is everyone around a big table sharing their ideas and thoughts. Here, it is like hosting a dinner party at your house every night and treating guests like they are friends, not customers."

This nightly, cuisine-centric gathering began three decades ago when Lucia opened Luciana's Ristorante in a historic cottage on Del Prado Avenue. Luciana's was the third restaurant for Lucia who strayed from an earlier casual deli and bistro model to form an elegant Italian escape in Dana Point. While the restaurant form changed, one constant remained—Vallera's kitchen presence, practicing her craft.

At just 6 years old, Vallera began making pastas by hand. She continued crafting handmade pastas—from fettuccini to ravioli—for more than nine decades. Well into her 90s, Nonna worked side by side with Luciana's staff to deliver patrons her signature dishes. She's since hung up her apron.

Retired or not, Vallera remains curious about the state and implementation of her recipes.

It is that fervor for family, food and tradition that Jorge Luhan carries on. From his dining table to Luciana's Ristorante, Jorge ensures that dinner around the table is the most important time.

"At Luciana's, we have the opportunity to sit and talk with customers to learn who that are and what they want," Jorge said, all part of the dinner party he hopes lasts well into the future.

## Capistrano Beach Neighborhood Watch

Neighborhood Watch is a crime prevention program which enlists the active participation of residents in cooperation with law enforcement to reduce crime in their communities. Neighborhood Watch involves neighbors getting to know one another and working together in a program of mutual assistance. Residents become trained to recognize and report suspicious activities, and can then implement the crime prevention techniques they have learned to ensure residential and vehicle security as well as personal safety in their neighborhoods.

The City of Dana Point and Dana Point Police Services are actively promoting the program and have recently held meetings in Capistrano Beach. The meetings at Capistrano Beach discussed launching the new Capistrano Beach Neighborhood Watch Program, taking an active role in "community policing", answered code enforcement questions, and addressed residents' concerns regarding sober living homes. At the end of the meeting, two Capistrano Beach residents volunteered to become block captains and will work on expanding the Neighborhood Watch Program in their neighborhoods.

Additionally Neighborhood Watch meetings can cover such topics as Home Security, Personal Safety, Identity Theft, and any other topics that your neighborhood may be interested in. Law enforcement personnel can also assist you with questions about crime in your community and provide valuable information on how the Sheriff's Department works.
