



Dana Point Harbor Time Capsule Unveiling

August 29th at 4pm

Fifty years ago on Monday, August 26, 1966, a rock-placing ceremony sponsored by the County of Orange, the Orange County Harbor District and local organizations marked the start of construction of Dana Point Harbor. The event took place at Doheny State Beach, during which a time capsule was sealed into a rock chosen from those forming the breakwater.

On May 6, 2016, Orange County Parks removed the 8-ton rock and took it to the John D. Cooper Archaeological and Paleontological Center in Santa Ana to prepare the contents for an exhibit. "The Rock" will be steam cleaned and placed at its new location, Baby Beach.

Please join us for the festivities at Dana Point Harbor's Baby Beach when the time capsule's contents will be revealed - exactly 50 years after the signature event. The unveiling ceremony will begin at 4pm and a welcome address will be made by Supervisor Bartlett.

COME TASTE WORLD CLASS BBQ IN YOUR OWN BACK YARD

October 8th

The City is pleased to present the 6th Annual Dana Point State BBQ Championship on Saturday October 8th at Sea Terrace Park. The event is free to the public and open from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This Kansas City Barbeque Society sanctioned contest features 100 competition barbeque teams from at least five different states pitted against each other to be crowned the Grand Champion. The teams compete in four categories: brisket, pork, ribs and chicken, with the overall points champion awarded the top prize. The public can sample the mouth-watering BBQ prepared by many competitors at just \$2 a tasting, with proceeds going to the Dana Point Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 9934.

Along with the BBQ, there will also be microbrew tasting, a food court and music. Proceeds generated from the food court and beverage area will support our 5th Marine Regiment Support Group, American Cancer Society Relay For Life, Pet Project Foundation and other non-profit groups that support our community. Shuttle buses will transport spectators from Dana Hills High School to the event and back, FREE of charge. Safe medication drop off is available within the **Dana Point Police Services lobby.**


No appointment is needed for this safe, free and anonymous disposal of prescription and OTC medication.

Whether it be at the City's Winter Festival & Tree Lighting event working the kid's craft area, or carrying a giant helium filled parade balloon in the Festival of Whales Parade, or at the Egg Hunts throwing out candy on the grass in preparation for the swarms of eager children with baskets in hand, or picking up trash and helping to break down equipment after our Movies in the Parks and Summer Concerts, Mike and the PATHS students are always ready to assist with smiles on their faces, positive attitudes and the desire to make a difference and serve our community.

The background of how this group was formed is a heartbreaking and heartwarming story, and one that makes you feel that our young people of today will continue to grow up to be adults who make a positive impact on society.

The Dana Point PATHS Club, formerly called S.O.S – Save Our Students, was formed 7 years ago. At that time there was an outbreak of deaths of young people in Orange County from prescription drug overdoses. It hit home with the students at DHHS, as one of their own tragically passed. A group of students approached Mike, who is the City of Dana Point Student Intervention and Support Specialist working on the campus of DHHS, and asked him to help them make a change to the culture on their campus. They wanted to show other students that you can have a fun, safe, rewarding High School experience without drugs and alcohol being involved. Thus, the S.O.S group was formed. The group focuses on positive experiences for the students by holding year round monthly beach BBQ's and getting the kids involved with community service by volunteering at events.

The S.O.S group recently changed their name to Dana Point PATHS. The PATHS students are positive role models and mentors and have helped create a more positive culture on campus, rather than reacting to crisis, they work to create a positive environment in school, in their homes and in the community, which will lead the students on the right PATH in life.

Today there are 82 students from Dana Hills High School, 20 students from Niguel Hills and Marco Forster participating in PATHS. They average 2,000 volunteer hours a year, and also volunteer at the Doheny Surf Festival, the 4th of July Day After Clean-up at Doheny, the Dana Point Grand Prix, The Dana Point Senior Center New Year's Eve Dinner/Dance and Valentine Dinner/Dance and they have even helped install fire alarms at local residences through the City's CERT program.
