Donna Kalez, San Clemente, long time business owner in Dana Point spoke regarding her support of the Tourism Business Improvement District and would like to see it to continue into 2012.

Russell Kerr, Laguna Niguel, Chairman of the Dana Point Chamber of Commerce spoke regarding his support of the Tourism Business Improvement District and encouraged the City Council to support it as well.

Mayor Schoeffel closed the item for public comments.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson voiced her concerns regarding the length of time that it has taken to reach this point and she would like to know why the logo has not been launched.

Council Member Bartlett urged everyone to be patient and to consider the scope of work involved, asserting that additional time is not an unreasonable request.

Council Member Brough voiced concerns over the lack of materials presented thus far, as well as, he would like clarification as to who the marketing firm's target audience was.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson suggested possibly opening the advisory committee to include other Dana Point business owners to allow for additional feedback from the local community.

Mayor Schoeffel acknowledged that this process was taking longer than he had anticipated and hoped. He felt, it was a valuable asset and that he would like to give them more time but with a sense of urgency.

Council Member Weinberg stated that the Tourism Business Improvement District meets on a part time basis and presented challenges concerning time on the hoteliers.
