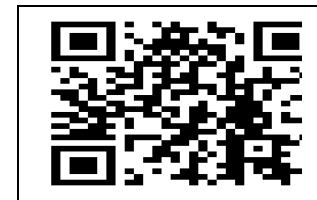

HISTORY OF OPERATION BABYLIFT

Operation Babylift (OBL) was the name given to the mass evacuation of orphans from South Vietnam at the end of the Vietnam War (April 3–26, 1975). President Gerald R. Ford, in a profound humanitarian act, authorized a \$2 million fund and announced that the U.S. government would begin evacuating Asian American orphans from Saigon on a series of 30 planned flights; these otherwise slated to be slaughtered children appealed by the press aroused worldwide action. This resulted in more than 2,700 children adopted in the United States and over 1,300 in Canada, England, Europe and Australia.

The OBL community consists of aircrew, caretakers, nurses, medical technicians, adoptive parents and adoptees. These war orphans and living survivors began their annual reunions in 2000. Endorsed by the Ford foundation, this year Torch 1975 Inc and VFW Post 9934 have the honor to host this OBL event. 2013 has more special impact as it is also the Centennial Birthday celebration for President Ford - the author of OBL. Torch 1975 and VFW Post 9934 are really looking forward to welcome the Vietnamese American babies that were rescued almost four decades ago.
