1. San Felipe de Jesus Chapel Update

There was a briefing by Chief Russ Chilton and Al Scaduto regarding recent crimes and activities that occurred at the Chapel which resulted in a temporary suspension of all homeless service related activities (e.g. feeds, showers, resource center, etc.). General discussion by task force members

concluded that by moving the services around isn't going to solve the issue; the homeless need a place to go.

2. Housing Options Discussion

The discussion commenced with a discussion about the need for a shelter and a need to do a count or census to determine the number of 'Dana Point' homeless and associated concerns (mental illness, drug addiction, etc.). A couple of the service providers shared their unique client data. The discussion transitioned into the different types of housing options and the purpose of each option; emergency shelter, rapid rehousing, permanent supportive housing, transitional housing, short-term transitional housing. Concluding remarks identified a short-term goal of addressing needs this winter, mid-term goals included transitional and rapid rehousing and a long-term goal included permanent supportive housing.

3. Summary

The task force agreed that Larry Haynes with Mercy House would be a good guest speaker at the next meeting and he would be able to address a variety of topics including housing, storage and resources.
