WELCOME

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Matt Davenport, Dana Point, thanked the City Council and staff for everything being done to improve the City. He stated that he was excited about the potential that is being created in the Doheny Village. He encouraged a measured approach when developing the area.

She suggested that the City work with OCTA to extend their hours on the weekends. She stated that she would like to see more mass transportation, pathways for walking, and bike rentals.
