# Redistricting Process

| <b>Two Initial Hearings</b><br>June 23 & July 20        | Held prior to release of draft maps.<br>Educate and solicit input on the communities in the Districts.                                  | ✓ |
| <b>Census Data Release</b><br>August 12, 2021           | Census Bureau released official 2020 Census population data.  | ✓ |
| <b>California Data Release</b><br>September 20-27, 2021 | California Statewide Database released California's official 'prisoner-adjusted' 2020 redistricting data.                               | ✓ |
| <b>Public Hearing #3</b><br>Nov. 16                     | Discuss and revise draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.   | ✓ |
| <b>February 8</b>                                       | Final draft map posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.   | ✓ |
| <b>Public Hearing #4</b><br><b>Feb. 15</b>              | Discuss and revise draft maps and discuss the election sequence.<br>Identify recommended final map and introduce an Ordinance to adopt. |   |
| <b>March 1</b>  | 2 <sup>nd</sup> Reading of Ordinance, final adoption date.  |   |
| <b>April 17, 2022</b>                                   | Legal deadline to adopt map. (Election minus 205)   |   |

# Redistricting Rules and Goals

## 1. Federal Laws

Equal Population  
Federal Voting Rights Act  
No Racial Gerrymandering



## 2. California Criteria for Cities (rank ordered)

1. Geographically contiguous
2. Undivided neighborhoods and “communities of interest”  
(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
3. Easily identifiable boundaries
4. Compact  
(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

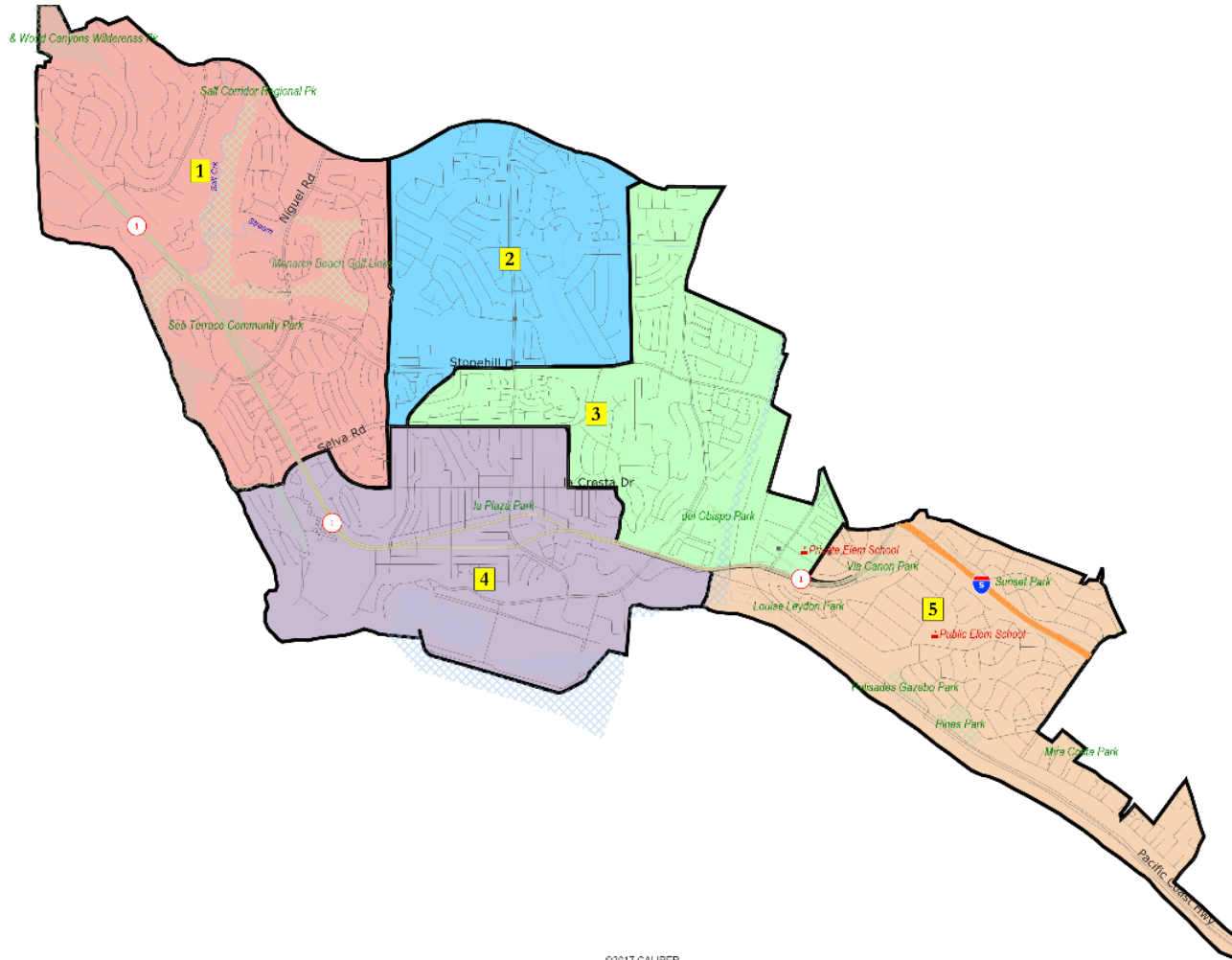
### Prohibited:

“Shall not favor or discriminate against a political party.”

## 3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

Minimize voters shifted to different election years  
Respect voters’ choices / continuity in office  
Future population growth  
Preserving the core of existing districts
