YOUTH BOARD REGULAR MEETING AGENDA

REVISED SAFETY ALERT (EFFECTIVE AS OF JUNE 2, 2020)

AS A RESULT OF THE COVID-19 VIRUS, AND RESULTING ORDERS AND DIRECTION FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AND THE ORANGE COUNTY HEALTH CARE AGENCY, AS WELL AS THE CITY OF DANA POINT EMERGENCY DECLARATION, THE PUBLIC HAS NOT BEEN PERMITTED TO PHYSICALLY ATTEND DANA POINT YOUTH BOARD MEETINGS SINCE MID MARCH, 2020. AS COVID-19 RELATED RESTRICTIONS EASE, THE PUBLIC WILL NOW BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND YOUTH BOARD MEETINGS PROVIDED SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES ARE FOLLOWED. THESE GUIDELINES WILL RESULT IN VERY LIMITED OPPORTUNITIES, ON A FIRST COME BASIS, FOR THE PUBLIC TO OBSERVE THE YOUTH BOARD MEETING FROM THE FOYER WHICH IS ADJACENT TO THE CHAMBER AND TO ENTER THE CHAMBER TO MAKE PUBLIC COMMENTS. MEMBERS OF THE YOUTH BOARD MAY CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE IN MEETINGS TELEPHONICALLY IF THEY CHOOSE PURSUANT TO GOVERNOR NEWSOM'S EXECUTIVE ORDER N-29-20.

PUBLIC COMMENT: PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE PROVIDED IN PERSON, ELECTRONICALLY OR BY MAIL. IF YOU CHOOSE TO ATTEND THE MEETING AND WISH TO DELIVER PUBLIC COMMENT IN PERSON, YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING. TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL PERSONS ENTERING CITY HALL. CITY STAFF IN ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETING WILL BE COORDINATING ENTRY TO THE CHAMBERS WHEN PUBLIC COMMENT IS OPEN. THERE WILL BE LIMITED SPACE AT THE YOUTH BOARD MEETING FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SIT OR STAND TO OBSERVE THE MEETING LIVE FROM THE FOYER ADJACENT TO THE CHAMBER. IF THAT SPACE IS EXCEEDED PERSONS WISHING TO PRESENT PUBLIC COMMENT IN PERSON WILL BE PERMITTED TO LINE UP OUTSIDE AND WILL BE ALLOWED TO SPEAK. AFTER SPEAKING, HOWEVER, THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO GO BACK OUTSIDE UNLESS
