### **DESCRIPTION**

The artwork, “Maddie's Dream Box” was created in honor of Maddie James, who passed away in 2011 from an inoperable brain tumor. Maddie's love for the ocean and legacy live on at the Maddie James Seaside Learning Center at the Ocean Institute in Dana Point Harbor. The larger box pays tribute to Maddie's dream that "every sea turtle doesn't eat plastic bags" and is illustrated by a collection of moon jellies and plastic bags, which are often consumed by sea turtles who easily mistake the two. The smaller box is designed to educate the public about what species are native to our local coastline.
