NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Dana Point will be holding a public meeting to discuss the removal of the crosswalk across Palisades Drive, on the north leg of the intersection of Coast Highway and Palisades Drive, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21950.5. A Project Description for the project in question is provided below.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Dana Point routinely evaluates streets and rights-of-way to find ways to enhance safety. One of the key projects that were developed by the City Council in this regard is known as the Annual Traffic Safety Improvements Project. The intent of this project/program is to implement improvements, which would enhance traffic safety and reduce accidents.

The City's Traffic and City Engineers have identified that a crosswalk at Coast Highway and Palisades Drive is no longer needed due to the modification in the configuration of Coast Highway between Palisades Drive and Camino Capistrano in recent years. Therefore, the crosswalk across the north leg of the intersection of Coast Highway and Palisades Drive is recommended for removal.

The public is encouraged to attend and express their concerns either in writing or orally.
