NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING (SECOND OPPORTUNITY)**

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**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council of the City of Dana Point will be holding a public meeting to discuss the consideration of posting new Street Sweeping Signs.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The City of Dana Point has been sweeping streets in the City since incorporation. Currently, the City sweeps all public streets weekly, but only restricts parking for that purpose during street sweeping hours in the Lantern Village and Town Center areas.

The City has invested significant resources over the years on public outreach and education, in an effort to encourage voluntary compliance. Upon review of the effectiveness of voluntary compliance, it has been determined that the public generally does not comply. This leads to dirty streets and more pollutants carried to Dana Point beaches through the storm drain systems.

It is recognized that moving cars for sweeping streets can be an imposition on residents who routinely park in the street. However, Police Services indicates that the need to move the vehicle on a weekly basis greatly reduces the number of abandoned or inoperable vehicles left on the street as well as those parked in front of neighbors for long periods of time, exceeding the 72-hour ordinance limit. In areas where posting exists today, Street Sweeping periods are posted for two hours to four hours on sweeping days, including an alternate side, alternate day methodology, limiting the inconvenience to residents.

The Traffic Improvement Subcommittee reviewed and discussed the issue of expanding the currently restricted parking areas for street sweeping at their last three meetings, culminating with a recommendation to the City Council to add the Doheny Village area, the upper Blue Lantern area, and several arterial streets.

The City Council will consider restricting parking during street sweeping in these areas of the City by posting Street Sweeping Signs to allow the sweeper to improve cleanliness and improve water quality.

The public is encouraged to attend and participate either in writing or orally.
