City Attorney Munoz announced that in regards to the City's cases against Beach Cities Collective, The Point Alternative Care, and Holistic Health the City has prevailed on summary judgment motions with respect to all three marijuana dispensaries. He stated that the City Attorney's office is in the process of preparing motions for collecting attorneys' fees that were incurred in those lawsuits. He stated that the City needs to present the legal billings to the court for that purpose. He reported that in Closed Session the Council voted to waive the attorney-client privilege with respect to the legal bills for the limited purpose of allowing them to bring those motions with the exception of certain attorney-client privilege materials within the bills that will be redacted. He stated the he would like the record to be clear that it is not a whole-sale waiver of the attorney-client privilege; it is merely with respect to those records for the purpose of the attorney fee motions only.
