eliminating the need for  
multiple flu vaccinations!**

**Remember — You cannot receive a flu shot if**

- You are sick on the day of vaccination,
- You are allergic to eggs,
- You have previously had a reaction to a flu shot,
- You have a history of Guillan Barre Syndrome.

**Seasonal Influenza vaccine is recommended for:**

- All healthy persons 6 months and older
- Adults who:
  - Are 50 years of age and older
  - Are pregnant during the flu season
  - Have chronic pulmonary, cardiovascular, renal, hepatic, cognitive, neurologic/neuromuscular, hematological, or metabolic disorders
  - Have immune-suppression
  - Are health-care personnel
  - Are household contacts and caregivers of:
    - Children age 5 years and younger and adults age 50 years and older, especially contacts of children less than 6 months of age
    - Persons with medical conditions described above.
